The York Local Plan has recently been adopted by the City of York Council and has been passed on to the Government Inspector in accordance with the laid down procedure.

Ward Councillors have been allocated additional funding for worthwhile projects within their respective areas.

The Number 18 Bus is to continue until July 2018, thanks to funding received from a number of Parish Councils along its route and Bubwith residents raised sufficient funds following the refusal of their Parish Council to provide any funding. Wheldrake Parish Council had also approved funding in principle, subject to formal approval at its May monthly Meeting.

Plans for a new Defibrillator to be positioned on the Industrial Estate were discussed together with the replacement of the one sited at the Wenlock Arms.
