26/113. Welcome

26/116. Playpark

To consider quotations for the repair or replacement of the nest and flat swings, agree a course of action, and determine the budget/reserve from which the expenditure will be funded.

The Council considered two quotations for the repair or replacement of the nest and flat swings. It was noted that both swings had been taken out of use following safety concerns. Members discussed the merits of repair versus replacement and obtaining a further quotation.

26/117. Section 106 monies

To consider the Sports S106 contribution of £92,006.22 and identify proposed project(s) and recipient(s) for the allocation of the funds.

The Clerk confirmed that City of York Council had asked the Parish Council, as the beneficiary of the £92,006.22 Sports S106 contribution, to identify proposed projects and recipients for the allocation of the funds. It was noted that the funding could be allocated across more than one project.

Members discussed potential projects, including sports field drainage, Phase Two of the WRA MUGA and maintenance of the Parish Council's existing MUGA.

It was agreed to invite local organisations and residents to submit proposals for consideration and to establish an application process. A public forum will subsequently be arranged to consider the proposals received.

Resolution: To invite proposals for the Sports S106 funding through the Parish Council's website and Facebook page, with the application process and closing date to be confirmed.
